The school will be conducting Home-based Learning for P1 to P2 students during Olympic Festival on **Fri**, **12.07.2024**. All P1 to P2 students are not required to report to school on 12.07.2024 and are to complete the home-based learning assignments.

G. RACIAL HARMONY DAY COMMEMORATION 2024

Schools commemorate Racial Harmony Day (RHD) on 21 July each year to mark the anniversary of the 1964 race riots. On this day, students reflect on and celebrate Singapore as a harmonious society built on a rich diversity of cultures and the collaborative effort of all to promote social cohesion.

Racial Harmony Day is a good opportunity for our students to:

- Make friends with people of other races and religions.
- Learn that in Singapore, people are treated equally regardless of their race and religion, and that students should appreciate the different cultures that make up Singapore.

The theme for RHD 2022 – 2024 is Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic. This theme reflects how each community, while having the space to express its own identity as part of Singapore society, also intertwines with others to depict the unique cultural diversity that characterizes Singapore life.

RMPS will be commemorating RHD on 17 July, with an assembly programme by the P4 NE Leaders, as well as class-based lesson packages. On 19 July 2024, there will be planned recess activities that will help the students develop respect and appreciation of the different cultures around them.

Students are also encouraged to come to school in their traditional/ethnic costume, with school shoes, on Friday, 19 July 2024. We hope that through this event, students will learn the importance of making choices to promote an inclusive society and strengthen the relationships amongst the multicultural population in our country.

H. MID-AUTUMN FESTIVAL CELEBRATION 2024 - RMPS CREATIVE LANTERN MAKING COMPETITION (Mr Wan Huaming, MTL HOD)

Radin Mas Primary School will be organising the Mid-Autumn Festival Celebration. More information on the celebration will be provided at a later date.

In conjunction with this celebration, we are organising the **RMPS Creative Lantern Making Competition** to create awareness on the importance of conservation. This competition aims to create an avenue for students and their parents to showcase creativity in using reused/ recycled materials to create lanterns.

We would like to invite **students and parents of Radin Mas Primary School** to participate in this Creative Lantern Making Competition. Attractive prizes will be awarded to the **TOP 3 Entries and 10 Consolation Entries**.

THEME:

This year, our theme for this Creative Lantern Making Competition is 'Together, As One United People'.

GUIDELINES:

- Creativity and originality in the design of the lantern.
- Capture the essence of the theme.
- Lanterns must be fabricated using **reused or recycled plastic materials** (such as plastic bottles, plastic takeaway containers) as the **main material**. Other recyclable materials such as straws, buttons etc. to be used as decoration for the lantern.
- No restriction on the number of recycled materials used for making the lantern.
- Lantern **size** should be **at least 40cm on one side** either in length, breadth or height.
- Lantern should not weigh more than 3kg.
- Provide a short description of the lantern.
- Label your lantern with your name, school and class. (Submit Entry Form with the lantern)

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Creativity (40%)
- Use of reused or recycled materials (20%)
- The extent to which the lantern captures the essence of the theme (20%)
- Overall presentation (20%)

DUE DATE:

- <u>26 August 2024</u>
- Students to submit their entries to their respective Form Teachers.
- Late entries will not be entertained and judges' decision will be final.

WINNING ENTRIES:

- TOP 3 Entries and 10 Consolation Entries will be awarded during the celebration.
- These lanterns will be displayed within the school compound after the celebration.

• Lanterns will be returned to the students after being displayed.

For this competition, our Art Teachers will brief the students during their art lessons.
